


Ultimate battle between Corporates for Business Excellence



Eligibility & Application process SCMHRD



Eligibility

- Project implementation period: Nov 2022 - Oct 2023, with improved results for at least 2 months prior submission
- New Projects which have not been submitted earlier in CEA are only eligible. Entries with projects submitted in earlier editions of CEA will be disqualified
- Multiple teams from an organization can participate.
- One team can present only one project per domain but can participate in multiple domains

Application

- Participants should upload a scanned copy of the application form duly filled and signed by signatory in PDF format. (Uploading the scanned copy is mandatory for the completion of the registration process)

Guidelines for Participants



- The event will be conducted in two stages: Preliminary round Online mode, Finale round On Campus. The
 projects qualifying for the finale round shall be presented in SCMHRD Campus, Pune
- Any number of teams can participate from a single organization
- A team can submit a maximum of one project per domain and can submit project in all domains. Each project has to be registered separately
- Registration fees: ₹ 5000/- for a team of 3 + Rs 1000 per additional member excluding GST per project (non refundable); GST will be levied on the total transaction value; Mode of Payment: Online (Only through Easebuzz payment gateway, No invoice will be generated for payment).
- Submission for preliminary round should be done online
- The organizers at their discretion may ask for a telephonic interview with the participants and / or the higher management representatives. This is to verify the validity of the submissions
- Decision of the organizers will be binding under all circumstances
- Executive Summary of the projects will be published in the event magazine. In case a company does not wish to publish their project, the team members should communicate it to the organizers before the preliminary round
- An undertaking (NOC) will be taken from the company before publishing the executive summary
- Format for Executive Summary will be shared by the organizers post registration
- Duly signed and stamped application form (Scanned copy in PDF format), Presentation (in PDF format) and Executive Summary for the project (in .DOC format) should be uploaded on the link which will be communicated post registration
- Participants can contact the organisers in case of any queries
- Late entries will NOT be accepted
- Participation will be confirmed and presentation will be allowed only upon receipt of the registration fees.



Guidelines for Presentation



- Overall time limit for presentation will be 20 mins: Presentation 15 mins, Q&A 5 mins
- Teams will present their project in the presence of other participants and the jury in the preliminary round. Projects selected for final round will be presented at SCMHRD, Pune in the presence of the Jury, other selected teams and the students of SCMHRD.
- Contents about Company introduction should be restricted to 1 slide
- Video content in the slide should not exceed 2 minute
- The appropriateness of the tool shall be evaluated
- Financial/ Customer benefit achieved should be shown with documentary evidence
- It is recommended that only the persons directly involved in the projects make the presentation
- Contents of the presentation should meet the evaluation criteria according to the domain
